ELIGIBILITY

- The contest is open to writers of any age.
- Past winners are not eligible to win.
- Employees of the City of Baltimore are not eligible to win but are encouraged to nominate individuals.

REQUIREMENTS

- The contest deadline is Friday, February 17, 2016.
- Essay must highlight a woman who is 18 years old or older.
- Nominees must live in Baltimore City, and has been an inspiration and/or role model to the writer of the essay.
- Individuals can nominate more than one person.
- A separate essay must be written for each person being submitted for consideration.
- The top of each page must include: Name of Author & Contact Information; Name of Person being written about in the essay & their contact information including email address and phone number.
- Essay(s) can be no more than 750 words but must be a minimum of 250 words.
- Essay(s) must be the original work of the submitter.
- Each essay must be typed in English, double-spaced, using a 12 point standard font with 1" margins on all sides. Recommended fonts: Times New Roman, Calibri, or Arial.
- Any quotations or copyrighted material must be identified properly. Failure to identify non-original material will result in disqualification.
- By submitting an essay, the writer agrees that the work may be reproduced in whole or in part at the editor's discretion and can be published in any format or forum without the expectation of financial compensation.

SUBMISSION

- All submissions must be RECEIVED by February 17, 2016.
- All submitters must complete and submit a registration form.
- Submissions may be emailed, faxed, or sent by regular 1st class mail.
- All submissions will be judged by a select panel of leaders from the Baltimore community.
